The undersigned agrees and understands that any grant received as a result of this application is subject to the following terms:

1. The statements contained in this application are true and complete to the best of your knowledge;
2. Funds granted as a result of this request will be expended for the project described in this application;
3. A system-generated report of expenditure of ASHP Foundation funds will be supplied to the ASHP Foundation upon completion or termination of the stated project period;
4. All reports of studies resulting from this grant shall acknowledge support of the ASHP Foundation as described in the application instructions and grant award letter;
5. If the findings of the above named study are presented at a national pharmacy meeting, ASHP retains the right of first refusal for presentation of the study and its findings at an ASHP meeting. If the study and its findings are presented at a medical or multidisciplinary meeting, the grantee should apply to also present the study and its findings at the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting that follows presentation at the medical or multidisciplinary meeting. Travel to the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting to present study findings should be supported through grant or institutional funds;
6. The ASHP Foundation requires submission of study results to a peer-reviewed scientific journal within 6 months of study completion. If the study results are submitted to a pharmacy journal, the *American Journal of Health-System Pharmacy* retains the right of first refusal for publication;
7. A copy of IRB or similar committee approval will be submitted with the original application or upon acceptance of the grant award. Copies of all IRB notices regarding study amendments, re-approval, and termination must be submitted to the ASHP Foundation within 30 days of their receipt by the principal investigator; and

The recipient institution will inquire into and, if necessary, investigate and resolve promptly and fairly all instances of alleged or apparent research misconduct related to this ASHP Foundation-sponsored research in accordance with federal regulations on research misconduct. If research misconduct occurs, the ASHP Foundation may withdraw approval of the principal investigator or other key personnel; disallow costs associated with the invalid or unreliable research; and suspend or terminate, in whole or in part, the grant award.
